


WHY are we doing Refurb ????????

- Refurb Phase 2- the Central area
- Splitting it down so its manageable Phase 2a The lounge
- Why the Lounge?
 - Roof,
 - No major heating issues,
 - Room that is used most
 - Looking very old and a bit shabby

So what happened next? – a few months ago

- PCC agreed to repair the roof
 - Using Refurb finds we had left over/ given since 2021 plus funds from Barnabas
 - £45k
- Suggestion that we as Church could redecorate the lounge
 - Paint
 - Curtains
 - Flooring
 - Chairs
- BUTStill issues regarding replacing Electrics, partition, false ceiling and Windows

Our building's Jubilee and the latest on its Refurbing

Dear friends of Brunswick Church.

In June 2024 the Brunswick Church building will be 50 years old, and on the weekend of June 29-30 we will be celebrating this jubilee with some special events - still being planned (ideas welcome!) For now we are inviting all of our exmembers (the 'Brunswick Diasphora') to join us on that weekend. We see it as a time to reminisce and reflect and rejoice in all that God has done in and through this particular part of His Church. And re-commit to more years to come as



we continue with our 'Refurb' project (watch out for a Jubilee Appeal to help fund some aspect - see list below). As an extra part of our jubilee year we have also invited our former curates to return on a Sunday morning in 2024 to preach, and share an update on life and ministry since Brunswick, with some memories and stories.

Refurb Project Phase Two

In May the PCC decided to do Refurb Phase 2 in chunks as and when funding becomes available.

2a The Lounge: The main item here is to finally sort out the roof which has leaked on and off for most of its 49 years! Numerous repair attempts have been made over the years, going back at least as far as 1979 with then Church Administrator Paul Keeble going up there with tubes of mastick (not in the original job description!) We will also redecorate and re-furnish, make some changes to the storage, and replace the sliding door (which, unlike the roof, has done very well to last this long) with a more modern, and hopefully more soundproof, one. 2b Next priority is the toilet block, also original. If you have memories of it from your time at Brunswick, it's exactly the same, apart from Ladies and Gents being swapped over a few years back for reasons that seemed good at the time, but now



Refurb update.....It was read

- We have had an offer to give a substantial gift for most of structural work
- WOW!

So whats happening now?....

- Work on the roof has begun cost covered (£45k)
- Windows are in £9,000
- New partition being prepared (10 weeks)
- New ceiling
- New lights total £35000
- Total about £43,000

Fabric costs

- Decoration £2000
- Curtain track £500
- Flooring £2300- £7 a tile (300)
- Curtains £250
- Chairs recover @ £20 £400 (2024 job)

Total £6,000
